Safety Tips for Noise Control in the workplace

1. Inspect and maintain plant equipment and machinery to ensure they are properly muffled.
2. Carry out noise monitoring at sensitive receptors locations and site boundaries.
3. Use Silencers, Acoustic Barriers, etc., if noise exceeds limit levels.
4. Locate compressors, generators, etc., as far away from sensitive receptors as possible.
5. Use electrical (rather than pneumatic or mechanical) equipment as much as possible.
6. Schedule particularly noise activities in accordance with the Government's restrictions.
