Safety Tips for Noise Control in the workplace

- 1. Inspect and maintain plant equipment and machinery to ensure they are properly muffled.
- 2. Carry out noise monitoring at sensitive receptors locations and site boundaries.
- 3. Use Silencers, Acoustic Barriers, etc., if noise exceeds limit levels.
- 4. Locate compressors, generators, etc., as far away from sensitive receptors as possible.
- 5. Use electrical (rather than pneumatic or mechanical) equipment as much as possible.
- 6. Schedule particularly noise activities in accordance with the Government's restrictions.
