Headlights – High Beams

High Beams

Every headlamp emitting a main-beam (bright), must be so adjusted and maintained that it shall be capable of adequately illuminating an area ahead of the motor vehicle, enabling the driver/rider to see any person, vehicle or substantial object at a distance of at least 100 meters.

Remember to dip the main-beam (bright) of your vehicle for oncoming traffic, as well as when following another vehicle.

Use When:

- No Oncoming Traffic
- Rural areas
- Open Highways
- Dimly lit areas

DO NOT Use When:

- Rainy Conditions
- Snow Ice and Fog
- In Urban areas
- Oncoming Traffic
